Dates to Remember

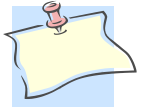
Wednesday, September 27th – Dolphin of the Month Chapel @ 8:00 AM

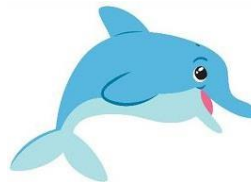

We will be recognizing the first Dolphins of the Month in chapel on September 27th. Who will it be?

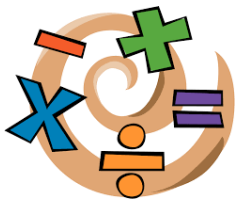
Pick Up and Drop Off

Please note the following when dropping off or picking up your student:

- You may drop off your student starting at 7:45 am in the morning. If dropping off before this time, you must enter the building, sign in your student and pay \$2 for Before Care.
- If you plan to enter the building, **please park in the grass parking lot**, not in the driveway or under the covered walkway
- Please do not block the driveway at any time for any reason. Also, if you need to assist your children into car seats, please pull out of the way so the rest of the traffic can pass through the drive.
- Please enter the school grounds using either of the 2 back entrances. Please exit out the front driveway.
- For the safety of all, please **do not** cut across the grass parking lot at any time for any reason.
- During Pick Up, please stay to the left or right in the driveway. Once your child is safely in your vehicle, please exit using the drive. There is room under the covered portion of the drive for 2 cars if everyone cooperates with the procedure.
